Amendments to the minutes of the Council meeting held on November 13<sup>th</sup> 2007 as agreed at the Council meeting on December 11<sup>th</sup> 2007

Min.3 Note - Ms Clark did not query the disabled ramp but the pathway through the hedge. Add "Cllr Whapham gave an assurance that no such pathway would be established at present although he stated it was in future plans. Cllr Conway queried who had decided on this as it had not been discussed or approved as far as he was aware."

Min. 6 (MF & JM) Note educational access money had not been received but "was expected soon."

Min. 6.1 Delete reference to rejuvenating the hedge.

Min. 6.1 Delete reference to "hard cut" as October mins. refer to "tidied"

Min. 6.1 Delete second paragraph and replace by "Cllr Richards assured the meeting that contrary to the Chairman's and Cllr Daly's accusations he had not advised the contractor to revise his price for work carried out to the hedge. However he confirmed he had spoken directly to the contractor to ascertain who had authorised the hedge to be cut down to within a foot of ground level. Cllr Richards then apologised to Cllr Daly for getting involved in the responsibilities of another councillor without reference. Cllr Daly accepted his apology."

Min.9 Last paragraph. Delete and replace with "After some discussion Cllr Whapham proposed that it should be established whether there were any restrictive covenants in place over the Gordon Jones Field which would prevent it being used as a potential site for a doctor's surgery. This was agreed (6 for, 2 against, 2 abstaining). The Clerk was requested to check on this."

Item 10 Correspondence

Add "Cllr Richards asked if all correspondence received by the council had been circulated to all councillors as it had taken since August for Mr Churton's letter to be circulated.
